



ILC VO Purpose and User Rules

Purpose:

An ILC VO has recently been established.

Rules:

1. Users who wish to use the computing resources at Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory (Fermilab) must accept and abide by the policies governing the use of computing resources at Fermilab. These policies are described at <http://security.fnal.gov/policies/cpolicy.html>
2. Users using the ILC VO must also accept and abide by the OSG Acceptable Use Policy described in [OSG-doc-86](#) (See <http://osg-docdb.opensciencegrid.org/>)
3. Users who will be using computing resources provided by ILC collaborators other than Fermilab must accept and abide by the fair use policies of the host institution providing the resource.

By registering with the ILC Virtual Organization (VO), you indicate your acceptance of the above policies. Failure to abide by these policies could result in revocation of your access to the resources and/or suspension of your ILC VO membership.
